It usually takes 4 to 6 hours with three to four girls braiding my hair, but I only had two this time, so I sat for 8 hours. Because it took so long, I had to reschedule my appointment with the lawyer to tomorrow at 2:00 pm and I will have dinner with my friend Jennifer this evening.

Tomorrow, besides meeting with the lawyer, I've got to tie up some loose ends with Hilda the new Ugandan administrator and I need to meet with Mary Lou one more time.

Since Matthew Emurai is waiting for his test scores, he had decided to go to his village. He will not start University until either August this year or January next year. That is how it works here.

I feel like I have accomplished all that I set out to do while here. The first six days of my arrival was a whirlwind. It would be nice to have better transportation here in Uganda, and better roads for that matter. But, maybe one day! ☺.

I board the plane tomorrow evening and will arrive in Denver the following day in the early afternoon hours.
